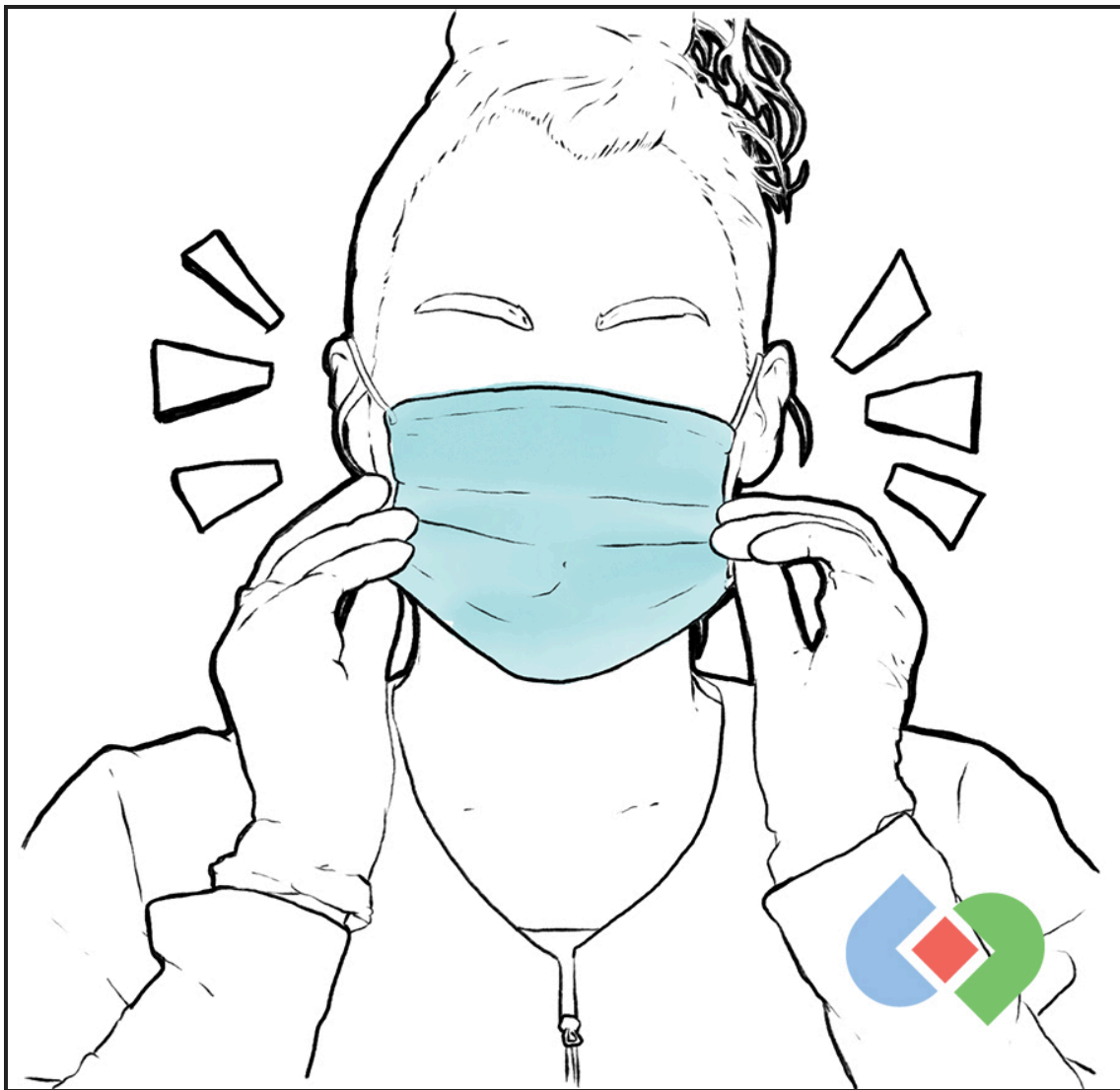

Open-Source PPE Manufacturing & Sterilization
